together with all rights, interests, casements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, the reats, issues, and profits thereofs and revenues and income therefore, all improvements and personal property now or later attached thereto or reasonably necessary to the use thereof, all water, water rights, and water actor, persioning thereto, and all poweries at any time owing to Borowest by virtue of any sale, lesse, transfer, conveyance, or condemnation of any part thereof or interest therein—all of which are brein called "the property";

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property unto the Government and its sesigns forever.

BORROUER for himself, his helies, executors, administrators, successors and assigns WARRANTS THE TITLE to the property to the Government against all lawful claims and demands whateover except any llens, encumbrances, excessors, reservations, or conveyances specified heritabove, and COVEMANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

(1) To pay promptly when due any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured and to indemnify and save harmless the Government against any loss under its insurance of payment of the onle by reason of sary default by Borrower. At all times when the note is held by an insured lende, procrower shall continue to make payments on the note to the Government, as collection agent for the holder.

(2) To pay the Government any initial fees for inspection and appraisal, and any delinquency charges, now or hereafter required by regulations of the Parmers Bone Administration.
