In case of default in the payment of any part of the principal indebtedness, or of any part of the interest, at the time the same becomes due, or in the case of failure to keep insured for the benefit of the mortgagee the houses and buildings on the premises against fire and tornado rish, and other casualties or contingencies, as herein provided, law; in either of said cases the mortgagee shall be entitled to declare the entire debt due and to institute foreclosure proceedings.

This right is cumulative and is not a waiver by the mortgagee of
