NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgage to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in half and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, the presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Town of Mauldin, being known and designated as Lot 60 on a plat of Bishop Heights Subdivision, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BBB, Page 171, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwestern edge of Leake Street, joint front corner of Lots 60 and 61 and running thence with the edge of Leake Street, S. 25-42 W., 100 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 60 and 59; thence with the line of Lot 59, N. 64-81 W., 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 25-42 E., 100 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 61, S. 64-81 E., 200 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to the mortgagor corporation by Leake & Garrett, Inc. by deed dated November 14, 1969, to be recorded herewith.

The mortgagor's promissory note referred to above contains, among other things, a provision for an increase in the interest rate.
