All that tract of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Northeastern side of East Georgia Road (State Road 143), being shown as a tract containing 75.9 acres, more or less, on a plat of the property of Frank L. Larkin, dated October, 1969, prepared by C. O. Riddle, R.L.S., recorded in Plat Book 4C at page 169 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

Lee, South 33 degrees 53 minutes West 792 feet; thence still with the Lee property, South 88 degrees 23 minutes West 99 feet to an iron pin; thence North 47 degrees 59 minutes West 524.7 feet to an iron pin; thence still with Lee property, South 46 degrees 55 minutes West 912.6 feet to an iron pin on East Georgia Road; thence with East Georgia Road, North 53 degrees 20 minutes West 399.8 feet to an iron pin; thence North 70 degrees 41 minutes West 585.4 feet to a nail and cap; thence North 66 degrees 41 minutes West 441.5 feet to an iron pin; thence North 72 degrees 40 minutes West 155 feet to a nail and cap; thence still with said Road, North 48 degrees 02 minutes West 309 feet to the beginning point.
