WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagoe for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Town of Mauldin, and being known as Lot 64 on a plat of Bishop Heights Subdivision by Ethan C. Allen, dated January 1966, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BBB at Page 171 and being described according to said plat, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern edge of Leake Street at the joint front corner of Lots 63 and 64 and running thence with the line of Lot 63, N. 64-18 W. 200 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corners of Lots 63 and 64; thence N. 25-42 E. 100 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lots 64 and 65; thence with the line of Lot 65, S. 64-18 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on the northwestern edge of Leake Street; thence with the edge of said street, S. 25-42 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to the mortgag or corporation by deed dated November 29, 1969 to be recorded herewith."

The mortgagor's promissory note referred to above, contains, among other things, a provision for an increase in the interest rate.
