 property being the real estate situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina.

All that certian piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be con-
 structed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Green-
 ville in the City of Greenville, Being known and designated as Lot No. 131, according to a
 plat of property of East Lynn Addition prepared by Dalton and Neves, Engineers in May, 1933,
 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in the Plat Book 8 at Page 220, and
 having, according to the said Plat, the following Metes and Bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Johnson Street at the joint front, Corner,
 of Lots, Nos, 130 and 131 and running thence along the joint line of said Lots S. 61-10 E.
 150 Feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots, Nos. 130 and 131, thence with the
 rear line of Lot No. 131, S. 28 - 50 Feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos.
 131 and 132, thence along the joint line of said lots N. 61-10 W. 150 feet to an iron pin,
