## MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

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WHEREAS, Ruthel Batson and Ruby Batson

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto A & A Discount Center, Inc.

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of in eighty-four (84) equal installments, commencing on the 10th day of February, 1970 and falling due on the same day of each subsequent month until paid.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further aums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his secount by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whence is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL, that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of \_\_Greenville ALL THAT CERTAIN piece, parcel or lot of land located in Greenville County, State of South Carol

ina near Paris Mountain Containing one acre, more or less, being more particularly described by the following metes and bounds; EEGINNING at an iron pin at the center of Fhillips Trail Road and running 372 feet N. 84-45 W. to stake; thence running for a distance of 140 feet in a south ernly direction to stake; thence 372 feet in an easterly direction to pin in center of Phillips Trail Read; thence with center of said road for a distance of 92 feet to the point of beginning. Said premises being the same conveyed to Ruthel Batson by H. B. Batson by deed recorded in 728 at 148.

Together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever,

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or bneumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encuments of the premises are free and clear of all liens and encuments to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgage forever, from and ngainst the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

- (1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgage for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgager by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original among shown on the face hereof. All Jums so advanced shall beer interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless offerwise provided in writing.
- (2) That it will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to that by the Mortgagee against less by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgagee, in an appendix off less than the mortgage debt it in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and renewals thefreshable be led by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premiums therefor when due; and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged premises and does hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the balance owing on the Mortgage debt, whether due or not.
- (3) That it will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter erected in good repair, and, in the case of a construction loan, that it will continue construction until completion without interruption, and should it fail to do so, the Mortgages may, at its option, enter upon said premises, make whatever repairs are necessary, including the completion of any constroin owerk undersoys, and charge the expenses for such repairs or the completion of such construction to the mortgage debt
- (4) That it will pay, when due, all taxes, public assessments, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines or other imposi-tions against the mortgaged premises. That it will comply with all governmental and municipal lews and regulations affecting the mortgaged premises.
- That it hereby assigns all rents, issues and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder.
- (5) That it hereby assigns all rents, issues and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and agrees that, should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, any judge having jurisdiction may, at Chambers or otherwise, apploint a receiver of the mortgaged premises, with full authority to take possession of the mortgaged premises and collect the rents; issues and profits, including a reasonable rental to be fixed by the Court in the event said premises are occupied by the mortgage, and after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceeding and the execution of its trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues and profits toward the payment of the dobt secured hereby, then at the option of the Mortgage, all sums then owing by the Mortgager tenthe Mortgage shall become immediately due and payable, and this mortgage may be forectosed. Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgage become impact of any authority at the Mortgage and a reasonable autorney's feet, shall thereupon become due and payable immediately or on demand; at the option of the Mortgage, as a fart of the dobt secured hereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder.
- (7) That the Morigagor shall hold and enjoy the premises above conveyed until there is a default under this mortgage or in the note secured hereby, it is the true meaning of this instrucent that if the Morigagor shall fully perform all the terms, conditions, and covenants of the mortgage, and of the note secured hereby, that then this mortgage shall be utterly null and void; otherwise to remain. in full force and virtue
- (8) That the covenants herein contained shall bind, and the benefits and advantages shall inure to, the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, of the parties hereto. Whenever used, the singular shall included the plural, the plural the singular, and the use of any gendig shall be applicable to all genders.
