"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, alluste, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northwest intersection of Wilton and Croft Streets and running thence with the said Wilton Street in a northerly direction 70 feet to a stake; thence in a westerly direction 151.9 feet to an iron pin; thence s. parallel with Wilton Street 70 feet to a stake on Croft Street; thence with said Croft Street 151.9 feet to the beginning corner.
