All that certain parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and known and designated as Lot No. 24, part of AVON PARK, according to plat by C. C. Jones, dated December, 1956, plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book KK, at Page 71, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
