County, State of South Carolina, containing one and one-half acres,
more or less, and having the following metes and bounds according
to survey made by T. T. Dill in August, 1948:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southwest corner of property formerly
known as Duncan Tract containing .36.7 acres, said pin being on the
bank of the G & N Railroad, and running thence with a county road,
N. 73-30 E. 308 feet to stone; thence, S. 47-30 E. 150 feet; thence,
S. 30 W. 257.4 feet to iron pin on G & N Railroad; thence with said
railroad as a line, N. 47-30 W. 348 feet to the point of beginning.
