TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditarients, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, including all heating, plumbing and electrical fixtures, and any other equipment of fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected or fitted in any manner. It being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household furniture, be considered their of the realty.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the salk propries unto the Mortgagee, its successors, and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is seized of the above described promises in fee simple absolute; that the above described premises are free and clear all hens or other encumbrances; that the Mortgagor is lawfully empowered to convey or encumber the same; and that the Mortgagor will forever defend the said premises unto the Mortgagor and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to thaim the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

- 1. That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest of the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage will secure the mortgage for any additional sums which may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, or public assessments, hazard insurance premiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any loans or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1962 Code of laws of South Carolina, in mineraled, or similar statutes, and all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as that provided in said note and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the prortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter to be creeted, insured against loss by fire, windstorm and other hazard, in a sim not less than the balance due hereunder at any time and in a company or companies acceptable to the Mortgagee, and Mortgagor does hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgagee and agrees that all such policies shall be sheld by the Mortgagee and shill include Joss payable clauses in favor of the Mortgage; and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give imited but notice thereof to the Mortgage by registered mail; and should the Mortgagor at any time fail to keep said premises insurance or fail to pay the premiums for such insurance; then the Mortgagee may cause such improvements to be insured in the name of the Mortgagor and reimburse itself for the cost of such insurance, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged promises in good repair and should Mortgagor tail to do so, the Mortgagec may, at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever repairs are necessary and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as thereinabove provided.
- 5. That the Mortgagee may at any time require the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person obligated under the indebtedness secured hereby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage debt, with the Mortgagee as beneficiary, and if the premiums are not otherwise paid, the Mortgagee may pay said premiums and any amount so paid shall become a part of the mortgage debt
- 6. That Morreagor agrees to pay all taxes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or before the due dates, hereof and to exhibit the receipts therefor at the offices of the Mortgager minediately upon payment, and should the Mortgager fail to pay such taxes and assessments when the same shall fall due, the Mortgager may at its option, pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage debt and collect the same amounter this mortgage, with interest as above provided.
- 7. That if this mortgage secures a "construction loan", the Mortgagor agrees that the principal amount of the indebtedness hereby secured shall be disbursed to the Mortgagor in periodic payments, as construction propriesses, in accordance with the terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but is made a part of this mortgage and incorporated herein by reference
- 8. That the Mortgagor will not further encumbes the premises above described, nor alternate said premises by way of mortgage or deed of conveyance without the prior consent of the Mortgage, and should the Mortgagor so encumber of alternate such premises, the Mortgagor may, at its option, declare 100 indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 9 That the Mortgagor hereby assigns to the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, all the rents planted and profits accruing from the mortgaged premises, retaining the right to collect the same so long as the debt hereby accured is not in account of payment, but should any part of the principal indebtedness, or interest, taxes, or fire misurance privalum, be past due and unpaid, the Mortgagee may without notice or further proceedings take over the nortgaged premises. If here shall be occupied by a tenant or tenants, and collect said rents and profits and apply the same to the indebtedness hereby decured, without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected, less the cost of collection, and any tenant is authorized, upon request by Mortgagee, to make all rental payments direct to the Mortgagee, without liability to the Mortgagee and should said premises at the time of such default be occupied by the Mortgagee, with Mortgagee may apply to the Judge of the County Court or to any Judge of the Court of Common life with shall be resident or presiding in the county aforesaid for the appointment of a receiver with authority to take possession of anything more than the rents and profits actually collected.
