NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first partyin hand paid by second party, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release, in fee simple, unto second party-its successors and assigns, the following described lands, including but not limited to, all trees, timber, shrubbery, fixtures and improvements now and hereafter thereon:

TRACT NO. 1: ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Grove Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, shown and designated as a 20.4 acre tract on a plat of property entitled "Property of Albert Q. Taylor", Greenville County, South Carolina, dated August 18, 1961, by C. C. Jones, Civil Engineer, recorded in Plat Book ZZ, at page 129, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina and being described as follows:
