SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I the said Jack E. Shaw  
hereinafter called Mortgagor, in and by my certain Note or obligation bearing even date herewith, stand indebted,  
firmly held and bound unto THE CITIZENS AND SOUTHERN NATIONAL BANK OF SOUTH CAROLINA,  
Greenville, S. C. hereinafter called Mortgagee, in the full and just principal sum of One Hundred Sixty  
Three Thousand and Eighty Two & 51/100 Dollars  
(\$163,082.51) with interest thereon payable monthly in advance from date hereof at the rate of Nine & One-half  
per cent per annum; the principal of said note together with interest being due and payable

in monthly installments as follows:

Beginning on the 1st day of October, 1970, and on the 1st day of each month thereafter  
the sum of Two Thousand One Hundred and No/100 Dollars  
(\$ 2,100.00) and the balance of said principal sum due and payable on the 1st day of April

1971. The aforesaid monthly payments of Two Thousand One Hundred and No/100 Dollars  
(\$2,100.00) each, are to be applied first to interest at the rate of Nine and One-half

per cent per annum on the principal sum of One Hundred Sixty Three Thousand Eighty Two and 51/100 Dollars  
(\$163,082.51), or so much as shall from time to time remain unpaid, and the balance of each monthly install-  
ment shall be applied on account of principal.

Said note provides that past due principal and/or interest shall bear interest at the rate of seven (7%) per  
cent per annum as reference being had to said note will more fully appear; default in any payment of either principal  
or interest to render the whole debt due at the option of the Mortgagee or holder hereof. Forbearance to exercise  
this right with respect to any failure or breach of the maker shall not constitute a waiver of the right as to any sub-  
sequent failure or breach. Both principal and interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America

at the office of the Mortgagee at Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as  
the holder hereof may from time to time designate in writing.

Carolina, County of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot 29 and portion  
of Lot 30 according to a plat of the Estate of Vance Edwards recorded in the RMC Office  
for Greenville County in Plat Book P, at Pages 128 and 129, prepared by Dalton & Neves,  
October, 1960, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the western side of Watson Road, joint front corner of  
Lots 28 and 29 and running thence with line of said Lots S. 80-12 W. 192 feet; thence  
S. 9-42 E. 125 feet; thence with new line through Lot 30 N. 80-12 E. 192 feet to an  
iron pin on the western side of Watson Road; thence with said Watson Road N. 9-42 W.  
125 feet to the point of beginning.
