4. All terms and conditions of the obligation shall continue in full force except as modified expressly by this agreement, and the statute of limitations will not commence to run against the obligation until the expiration of the time for payment of the indebted ness as herein extended.
5. This agreement shall bind jointly and severally the heirs, the executors, the administrators, the successors and the assigns of the Corporation and of the Obligor, respectively.
