NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the north side of Hollis Street, in the City of Greer, and being known and designated as Lot No. 12 as shown on plat entitled "Subdivision of Greer Mill Village, Greer, S. C." made by Dalton & Neves, Jan., 1951, and which plat has been recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book Y, Pages 138 and 139. According to said plat, the within described lot is also known as No. 24 Hollis Street, and fronts thereon 84 feet. This is the same property which was conveyed to James L. Woodward and Walter E. Woodward by J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc. by deed recorded in Deed Book 444, Page 381, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County. James L. Woodward conveyed his interest in said lot to Walter E.
