Whereas, I the said Rose Anna Mack

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am (are) well and truly indebted to Piedmont Construction Company in the full and just sum of Five Hundred Ninety-Seven and 78/100 - - - - - - Dollars, (\$ 597.78) payable thirty-three and 21/100 (33.21) Dollars on November 23, 1970 and thirty-three and 21/100 (33.21) Dollars on the 23rd. of each and every month thereafter until the entire amount is paid in full.

, with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of eight per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid Semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Piedmont Construction Company according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Rose Anna Mack

, in hand and truly paid by the said Piedmont Construction Company at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Piedmont Construction Company, its heirs and assigns, FOREVER:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in the City of Greenville, on Calhoun Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin on Calhoun Street, the corner of property formerly known as the old Hewell property, and running thence along Calhoun Street North 18 East Forty-three feet, more or less, to a stake; thence North 72 West Ninety-five feet, more or less, to a stake; thence South 18 West Forty-five feet, more or less, to a stake on the old Hewell line; thence along said line South 76 East Ninety-seven feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, according to plat thereof as made by E. H. McCollough, dated March 9, 1909, which plat is hereby referred to for a more particularly description thereof, being known as Lot Number Seven.
