Forrester and Kenneth Forrester and their heirs and assigns forever:

All that parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the northeast side of a paved highway, sometimes known as the Barnett Road, near the Mt. Lebanon Church and in the old Jordan School Community, being shown on a plat designated as property of Louie E. Babb made by Terry T. Dill, Surveyor, dated November 19, 1959, recorded in Plat Book OO at Page 392, and having the following courses and distances:
