"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northwestern side of Lockwood Avenue in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 69 on plat prepared by Woodward Engr. Co., dated September 1955, entitled "Elletson Acres, Section A," recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE at page 161, and having according to a more recent survey prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated June 20, 1957, entitled "Property of Hugo Baldelli and Helen F. Baldelli" and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book NN at page 109, the followingmetes and bounds:
