BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Highway #176 leading from Tryon to Landrum which iron pin is 268.9 feet from an iron pin on the Southwestern side of said highway on the North Carolina-South Carolina State line and running thence along the Southwestern side of said highway three calls as follows: South 46 degrees East 10.1 feet, South 43 degrees 30 minutes East 35 feet, and South 43 degrees 01 minutes East 30 feet to an iron pin; thence leaving said highway South 46 degrees 51 minutes West 86.1 feet to an iron pin on the Northern bank of a small stream; thence on the Northern bank of a small stream; thence on the Northern bank of said stream North 52 degrees 45 minutes West 75.8 feet to an iron pin; thence North 46 degrees 42 minutes East (passing an iron pin at 62 feet) 98.1 feet to the point of BEGINNING.
