MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

Flat Rock Church (Flat Rock Baptist Church). by Willie S, Moon. Dave N. Walker, as Trustees, and Charles M. Dogan, as Deacon (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of Sixty-Five Thousand and No/100 (\$65,000.00)

Dollars as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of Five Hundred Eighty-Four and 83/100-----(\$ 584.83) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable 20 years after date; and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagoe for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as property of Flat Rock Church as is more fully shown on plat of property thereof prepared by Jones Engineering Services dated April 11, 1969, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of a county road leading to Augusta Road 12,554 feet from its intersection, and running thence along a line of property now or formerly of Martin, passing an iron pin 25 feet from the center of said road, S. 41-00 E. 288.4 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of property now or formerly of W. T. Martin, S. 50-13 W. 530.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 83-57 W. 128.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 32-48 W. 314.3 feet, passing an iron pin 25 feet from the center of said county road to a point in the center of said county road; thence with the center line of said county road, N. 53-36 E. 77.4 feet to a point; thence continuing with the center of said road, N. 60-06 E. 525.3 feet to the point of beginning; being the same property conveyed to the Deacons of Flat Rock Church by W. B. Charles by deed dated February 1, 1890 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book VV, at Page 531 and by deed of W. T. Martin dated June 22; 1920 to the Trustees of Flat Rock Church, recorded in said R. M. C. Office in Deed Vol. 70, at Page 12.
