"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the town of Travelers Rest, on the southeast side of U. S. Highway 25, now being the Old Highway 25 and referred to as Poinsett Highway. and being a part of the Cosy Cabin property and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of said Highway at the corner of Clyde and Corine H. Green, and running thence along said Highway N. 53-25 E. 42.7 feet to an iron pin in the line of Green; thence S. 42-15 E. 86.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 3-10 E. 62.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 53-30 W. 18 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 35-58 W. 139.3 feet to the point of beginning being the same property conveyed to the present Grantor by Deed which is recorded in the R.M.C.
