To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

Ward S. Stone and Ledger D. Weber (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

Seven Thousand and No/100-----
DOLLARS (\$ 7,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight (8%)
per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville
Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 7 and 8 of Block A of a subdivision known as Jefferson Heights as shown on a plat thereof being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C at Pages 34 and 35, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of First Avenue (now known as Rebecca Avenue), joint front corner of Lots 8 and 9 and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 81-40 E. 87.5 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 33; thence with the rear line of Lots 33 and 32, N. 0-30 E. 51 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 6 and 7; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 81-40 W. 87.5 feet to an iron pin on the western side of First Avenue; thence with First Avenue, S. 0-30 W. 51 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to us by Theodore V. Howie and Heyward R. McConnell by deed dated March 12, 1971 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 913 at Page 417.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
