"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 3 of the subdivision to be known as Buckhorn Village, and being more particularly described according to a recent survey by C. C. Jones as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Harding Drive, which pin is 201.4 feet south of the turnout point of Harding Drive and Buckhorn Road, and is the joint front corner of Lots 2 and 3; and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 72-30W. 165 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 17-30 E. 80 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of Lot 4; thence with the line of said lot, N. 72-30 E. 165 feet to an iron pin in the western side of Harding Drive; thence with said Drive, N. 17-30 W. 80 feet to the point of BEGINNING.
