All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 277 on plat of Section B of Gower Estates, on the west side of Wembley Road, made by R. K. Campbell, Surveyor, December 1961, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book XX at Pages 36 and 37 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
