"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, on the Northwestern side of View Mont Drive, containing 1.54 acres, more or less, and having, according to a plat prepared by J. C. Hill dated May 20, 1952, entitled "Property of Mrs. Corinne B. George" and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book T at page 435, the following metes and bounds:
