WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government will execute and deliver to the insured lender along with the note an insurance endorsement insuring the payment of all amounts payable to the insured lender in connection with the loan; and WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government by agreement with the insured lender set forth in the insurance endorsement may be entitled to a specified portion of the payments on the note, to be designated the "annual charge"; and

WHEREAS, a condition of the insurance of phyment of the note will be that the holder will forego his rights and remedies against Borrower, and any others in connection with the loan evidenced thereby, as well as any benefit of this instrument, and will accept the benefits of such insurance in lies thereof, and upon the Government's request will assign the note to the Government; and WHEREAS, it is the purpose and latest of this instrument that, among other things, at all times when the note is held by the Government,

which the Government should assign the instrument without insurance of the note, this instrument shall secure payment of the note; but when the note is held by an insured leader, this instrument shall not secure payment of the note or attach to the debt evidenced thereby, but as to the note and such debt shall complicate an indemnity mortgage to secure the Government against loss under its insurance endorse-

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the loan(s) and (a) at all times when the note is held by the Government, or in the event the Government should assign this instrument without insurance of the payment of the note, to secure prompt payment of the note and any entered and extensions thereof and any agreements contained therein, including any provision for the payment of an insurance or other charge, (b) at all times when the note is held by an insured lender, to secure performance of Borrower's agreement herein to indemnify and harmless the Government against loan moder its insurance enforcement by reason of any default by Borrower, and (c) in any event and charge, (b) at all times when the note is neid by an insured lender, to secure performance or isomower's agreement nerein to indemnity and have harmless the Government against loss under its insurance endorsement by reason of any default by Borrower, and (c) in any event and all times to secure the prompt payment of all advances and expenditures made by the Government, with interest, as hereinafter described, and the performance of every covenant and agreement of Borrower contained herein or in any supplementary agreement, Borrower does hereby grant, bergain, sell, release, and assign unto the Government, with general warranty, the following property situated in the State of South Carolina, County(ies) of Greenville
