NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, City of Greenville, (formerly West Greenville) known as No. 16 on map of West Greenville, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the south side of Doe Street at corner of lot formerly owned by Lula J. Griffin and now occupied as a store; thence in an easterly direction with Doe Street, 47½ feet to a point; thence in a southerly direction parallel with the Griffin line, 96 feet to a stake; thence parallel with Doe Street in a westerly direction, 47½ feet to a stake; thence 96 feet in a northerly direction with the Griffin line to the beginning corner.
