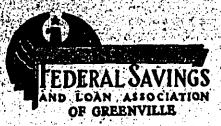

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as lots nos.

45 and 46 and part of lots nos. 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38 and 39 in the subdivision known as Augusta Terrace shown on a survey, plat of which was made by Dalton & Neves, in March, 1930, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book G at Page 265, redrawn August, 1946, and having according to said survey, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the corner of lots 46 and 47 on Old Augusta Road and running thence S. 29-18 E. 161.2 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of lots 46, 47, 33 and 34; running thence N. 60-42 E. 25 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot 33; running thence S. 29-18 E. 75 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 57-07 W. 165 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 28-70 W. 87 feet to an iron pin; running thence along Old-Augusta Road, N. 12-50 E. 214.7 feet to an iron pin, to the beginning corner.
