All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of GREENVILLE, near the Town of Simpsonville, containing 1.88 Acres, more or less, according to a Plat prepared by C. O. Riddle, dated December 29, 1971, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
