WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY AND No/100----- DOLLARS

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying on the southeastern side of Dunagan Street, off the Anderson Road, and known and designated as Lot 20 on a plat of property of Mollie Fortner dated July 22, 1922, by R. E. Dalton and recorded in Plat Book F at Page 73 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of an unnamed street (now known as Dunagan Street) at the joint front corner of Lot 19 and Lot 20 and running thence N. 34-34 E. 50 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lot 20 and Lot 21; thence with the line of Lot 21 S. 50-34 E. 200 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lot 20 and Lot 21; thence S. 34-34 W. 50 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lot 19 and Lot 20; thence N. 50-34 W. 200 feet to the beginning point.
