Invalidation of any one of the provisions contained in this mortgage by judgment or Court Order shall in no wise affect any of the other provisions herein, which other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the said parties in case of default in any of the payments of interest or principal as herein provided for, the whole amount of the debt secured by this mortgage shall become due and payable at once.

AND IT IS FURTHER AGREED, that said mortgagor(s) She heirs and assigns, shall pay promptly all taxes assessed and chargeable against said property, and in default thereof, that the holder of this mortgage may pay the same, whereupon the entire debt secured by this mortgage shall immediately become due and payable, if the mortgagee shall so elect.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, NEVERTHELESS, and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents, that if the said mortgagor(s) do and shall well and truly pay, or cause or be paid unto the said mortgagee, its successors or assigns the said debt or sum of money aforesaid, with interest thereon, if any shall be due, according to the true intent and meaning of the said note and condition thereunder written, then this deed of bargain and sale shall cease, determine and be utterly null and void. And the said Mortgagor(s) do hereby assign, set over and transfer to the said mortgagee, its successors and assigns, all of the rents, issues and profits of the said mortgaged premises; accruing and falling due from and after the service of a summons issued in action to foreclose this mortgage after default in the conditions hereof.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. Including but not limited to all buildings, improvements, fixtures, or appurtenances now or hereafter erected thereon, including all apparatus, equipment, fixtures, or articles, whether in single units or centrally controlled, used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration, ventilation or other services, and also together with any screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, screen doors, awnings, stoves and water heaters (all of which are declared to be a part of said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not).

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the said mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever. And the mortgagor(s) do hereby bind She heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said mortgagee, its successors and assigns from and against she heirs, executors, administrators and assigns and all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
