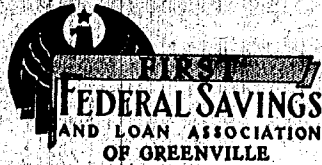

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Martha A. Corn, of Greenville County

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

Thirteen Thousand and No/100----- (\$ 13,000.00 )

Dollars as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note does not contain a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of

Ninety and 90/100----- (\$ 90.90 ) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable 30 years after date; and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collateral given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying, and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the western side of a county road leading from Mauldin to Log Shoals Road, being shown on the County Tax Maps as Sheet 573.1, Block 1, Lot 4 and being described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of said county road at the corner of property now or formerly owned by C. O. Abercrombie and running thence N. 66-42 W. 250.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1-40 E. 137.6 feet to an iron pin at the corner of property of L. L. Best; thence N. 82-10 E. 201.5 feet to a point in the center of said road; thence with the center of said road, S. 1-42 W. 110 feet to a point; thence continuing with said road, S. 5-45 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner. Said property is the same conveyed to me by C. O. Abercrombie by deed dated June 28, 1952 and recorded in Deed Vol. 458 at page 252, less that portion sold by Martha A. Corn to Luther L. Best by deed dated November 29, 1963 and recorded in Vol. 739 at page 87, plus the property conveyed to Martha A. Corn by Luther L.
