at that time it is insured under the provisions of the National Housing Act, he will pay to the Mortgages an insure ance premium charge of one per centum (1%) of the original principal amount thereof, except that in no event shall the adjusted premium exceed the aggregate amount of premium charges which would have been payable if the mortgage has continued to be insured until maturity; such payment to be applied by the Mortgages upon its obligation to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development on account of mortgage insurance.

2. That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, he will pay to the Mortgagee; on the first day of each month until the said note is fully paid, the following sums:

- (a) An amount sufficient to provide the holder hereof with funds to pay the next mortgage insurance premium if this instrument and the note secured hereby are insured, or a monthly charge (in lieu of a mortgage insurance premium) if they are held by the Secretary of Housing and Urhan Development, as follows:
 - (I) If and so long as said note of even date and this instrument are insured or are reinsured under the provisions of the National Housing Act, an amount sufficient to accumulate in the hands of the holder one (I) month prior to the date the annual mortgage insurance premium in order to provide such holder with lunds to pay such premium to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development pursuant to the National Housing Act, as amended, and applicable Regulations thereunder; or
 - (II) If and so long as said note of even date and this instrument are held by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, a monthly charge (in free of a mortgage insurance promium) which shall be in an amount equal to one twelfile (1/12) of one-half (4) per centum of the average outstanding balance due on the note computed without taking anto account delinquencies or prepayments.
- The A sum equal to the ground rents. If any nekt due, plus the premiums that will next become the and payable on policies of fire and other hazard indurance covering the mortgaged property plus taxes and assessments next due on the mortgaged property (all as estimated by the Mortgaged) less all sums already paid therefor divided by the number of months to also be fore one (1) month prior to the data when such ground rents, promitims, taxes, and assessments will become dollinquent, which sums to be held by Mortgagee in trust to pay said ground rents, promitims, taxes, and special assessments; and secured hereby shall be added together and the aggregate amount thereof shall be paid by the Mortgager each month in a saugic payment to be applied by the Mortgagee to the following items in the order set forth:
 - (1) premium charges under the contract of insurance with the Secretary of Housing and Urban Developments of monthly charge (in lieu of mortgage insurance premium), as the case may be:
 - (II) taxes, special assessments, fire and other hazard insurance promiums;
 - (III) interest on the note secured frereby, and
 - (IV) amortization of the principal of said note:

Any deficiency in the amount of any such aggregate monthly payment, shall, unless made good by the Mortgagor prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this mortgago. The Mortgago may collect a "late charge" not to exceed two cents (2¢) for each dollar (\$1) of each payment more than diffeon (13) days in arrears to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments.

3. If the total of the payments made by the Mortgagor under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding shall exceed the amount of pay ments actually made by the Mortgagee for taxes or assessments or insurance premiums, as the case may be such excess, at the option of the Mortgagee, shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, or refunded to the Mortgagor. If, however, the monthly payments made by the Mortgagor under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding shall not be sufficient to pay taxes and assessments and insurance premiums, when the same shall become due and payable, then the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee any amount necessary to make up the deficiency, on or before the date when payment of such taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums shall be due. If at any time the Mortgagor shall tender to the Mortgagos in accordance with the provisions of the note secured hereby, full payment of the entire indebtedness represented thereby, the Mortgagee shall, in computing the amount of such indebtedness, credit to the account of the Mortgagor all payments made under the provisions of (a) of paragraph 2 hereof which the Martgagee has not become obligated to pay to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, and any balance remaining in the funds accumulated under the provisions of (b) of paragraph 2 hereof. If there shall to a default under any of the provisions of this mortgage fesulting in a public sale of the promises covered hereby, or if the property is otherwise acquired after default, the Mortgagee shall apply, at the time of the commencement of such proceedings, or at the time the property is otherwise acquired, the balance then remaining in the funds accumulated under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding, as a credit against the amount of principal then remaining unpaid under the note secured hereby, and shall properly adjust any payments which shall have been made under (a) of paragraph 2.

4. That he will pay all taxes, assessments, water rates, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines, or impositions, for which provision has not been made hereinbefore, and in default thereof the Mortgagee may pay the same, and that he will promptly deliver the official receipts therefor to the Mortgagee. If the Mortgager falls to make any payments provided for in this section or any other payments for taxes, assessments, of the like the Mortgagee may pay the same and still sums so paid shall bear interest at the rate set forth in the note secured hereby from the date of such advance and shall be secured by this mortgage.

5. That he will keep the premises in as good order and condition as they are now and will not commit or permit any waste thereof, reasonable wear and tour excepted.

6. That he will keep the tipprovements now existing or hereafter eracted on the mortgaged property insufed as may be required from time to the by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and other hazards, casualties and contingencies in such amounts and for such periods as may be required by the Mortgagee and will pay promptly when due, any premiums on such insurance provision for payment of which has not been made hereinbefore. All insurance shall be carried in companies approved by the Mortgagee and the palicies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee. In event of loss Mortgagor will give immediate notice by mail to the Mortgagee, who may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Mortgagor, and each insurance company, concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to the Mortgagee instead of to the Mortgagor and Mortgagee fointly, and the insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, may be applied by the Mortgagee at its option either to the restoration of repair of the property damaged. In event of foreglosure of this mortgage or other transfer of fitte to the Mortgaged property in extinguishment of the indebtedness secured hereby, all right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to any insurance policies them in force shall pass to the purchaser or grantee.

7. That he hereby assigns all the rents, issues, and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and should legal proceedings by instituted pursuant to this instrument, then the Mortgages shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the rents, issues, and profits, who, after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceedings and the execution of the trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues, and profits, toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.
