BORROWER for himself, his beirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns WARRENTS THE TITLE to the property to the Government against all lawful claims and demands whatsoever except any liens, encumbrances, easements, reservations, or conveyances specified hereinabove, and COVENANTS AND AGREES as follows:

- (1) To pay promptly when due any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured and to indemnify and save hamiless the Government against any loss under its insurance of payment of the note by reason of any default by Borrower.
