"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Cleveland Township, lying and being on the north side of Middle Saluda River, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at the mouth of a branch, corner of lot previously sold to W. G. Buchanan, and running thence up said branch N. 27½ E. 3.00 chains (198 feet) to a Holly at Buchanan's corner; thence S. 31½ E. 3.72 chains (245.52 feet) to a pin on Middle Saluda; thence up said river to the beginning corner.
