TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: Mildred G. Burnette

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto Bank of Travelers Rest

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of

One Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-Four and 50/100^{ths} DOLLARS (\$ 1,594.50),
 with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7% per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: at the rate of \$53.15 on September 25, 1972, and a like payment on the first day of each month thereafter until paid in full with interest from date at the rate of 7% per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually in advance.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Cleveland Township, situate on the Northwestern side of U. S. Highway 276, at its junction with the G. & N. Railway, and having according to plat of property of Mildred G. Burnette, made by Terry T. Dill, June 24, 1964, the following metes and bounds, TO-WIT:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of Geer Highway (or U. S. Highway 276) and the Greenville and Northern Railway, and running thence with the center of said Highway as a line N. 52-53 E. 324 feet; thence N. 13-06 W. 125 feet to an iron pin at a poplar; thence N. 57-16 W. 39 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 72-16 W. 90 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 87-46 W. 171 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 27-45 W. 218 feet to an iron pin in the center of railway track; thence with center of said track as a line S. 41-30 E. 238 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by deed recorded in Deed Book 310 at Page 365.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
