TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, including all built-in stoves and refrigerators, heating, air conditioning, plumbing and electrical fixtures, wall to wall carpeting, fences and gates, and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected or fitted in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household furniture, be considered a part of the realty.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgages, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is selzed of the above described premises in fee simple absolute; that the above described premises are free and clear of all lieus or other encumbrances; that the Mortgagor is lawfully empowered to convey or ensumber the same; and that the Mortgagor will forever defend the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, from any against the Mortgagor and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

## THE MORTCAGOR COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage will secure the Mortgagee for any additional sums which may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, or public assessments, hereird insurance premiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any loans or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgager under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1962 Code of laws of Sauth Capolina, as amended, or similar statures; and all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate or rates as that provided in said note unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the mortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter to be erected, insured against loss by fire, windstorm and other hazards in a sum not less than the balance due hereunder at any time and in a company of companies acceptable to the Mortgagee, and Mortgagee should it so require and shall include loss payable clauses in favor of the Mortgagee, and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give immediate notice thereof to the Mortgagee by registored mail; and should the Mortgagor and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give immediate notice thereof to the Mortgagee by registored mail; and should the Mortgagor and in the event of loss, mortgager may cause such improvements to be insurance, then the Mortgagee may cause such improvements to be insurance, with interest as hereinghove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premises in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so the Mortgagee may at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever repairs are necessary and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this inortgage, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 5. That the Mortgagee may at any time require the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person obligated under the indebtachess secured hereby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage slebt, with the Mortgagee as beneficiary, and if the premiums are not otherwise part, the Mortgagee may pay said premiums and any amount so paid shall be premium a part of the mortgage debt.
- 6. That Mortgagor agrees to pay all taxes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or before the due dates thereof and to exhibit the theology therefor at the offices of the Mortgage immediately upon payifiest, and should the Mortgagor fail to pay such taxes and assessments when the same shall fall due the Mortgagoe may, at its official, pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as allow provided.
- 7. That if this mortgage secures a "construction loan", the Mortgagor agrees that the principal amount of the indebtedness hereby secured shall be disbursed to the Mortgagor in periodic payments, as construction progresses, in accordance with the terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but is made a part of this mortgage and incorporated herein by reference.
- 8. That the Mortgagor will not further encumber the premises above described, without the prior consent of the Mortgagee, and should the Mortgagor so encumber such premises, the Mortgagee may, at its option, declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 9. That should the Mortgagor alternate the mortgaged premises by Contract of Sale, Bond for Title, or Deed of Conveyance, and the within mortgage indebtedness is not paid in full, the Mortgagor or his Purchaser shall be required to file with the Association an application for an assumption of the mortgage indebtedness, pay the reasonable cost as required by the Association for processing the assumption furnish the Association with a copy of the Contract of Sale, Bond for Title, or Deed of Conveyance, and have the interest rate on the loan balance existing at the time of transfer modified by hiereasing the interest rate on the said loan balance to the maximum rate per annum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase in interest rate as may be determined by the Association. The association will notify the Mortgagor or his purchaser of the new interest rate and monthly payments, and will mail him a new passbook. Should the Mortgagor, or his Purchaser, fail to comply with the provisions of the within paragraph, the Mortgagee, at its option, may declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 10. That should the Mortgagor fall to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissory note and the same shall be unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or if there should be any failure to comply with and abide by any by-laws or the charter of the Mortgage, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the Mortgage, at its option, may write to the Mortgagor at his last known address giving him thirty (30) days in which to rectify the said default and should the Mortgagor fall to rectify said default within the said thrivt days, the Mortgagor, may, at its option, increase the interest rate on the loan balance for the remaining term of the loan or for a lesser term to the maximum rate per annum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase rate as may be determined by the Association. The monthly payments will be adjusted accordingly.
- 11. That should the Mortgagor fail to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissory note and should any monthly installment become past due for a period in excess of 15 days, the Mortgagoe may collect a "late charge" not to exceed an amount equal to five (5%) per centum of any such past, the installment in order to cover the extra expense incident to the handling of such delinquent payments.
- 12. That the Mortgagor hereby assigns to the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, all the rents, issues, and profits accruing from the mortgaged premises, retaining the right to collect the same so long as the debt hereby secured is not in arrears of payment, but should any part of the principal indebtedness, or interest, taxes, or fine assurance primitims, be past due and unpaid, the Mortgagee may without hotice or further proceedings taxe over the nortgage of premises. If they shall be occupied by a tenant or tenants, and collect said rents and profits and apply the same to the indebtedness hereby secured without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected, less the cost of collection, and any tenant is authorized, upon request by Mortgagee, to make all rents and profits actually collected, less the cost of collection, and any tenant is authorized, upon request by Mortgagee, to make all rents and irrent to the Mortgagee, without liability to the Mortgager, until notified to the contrary by the Mortgagee; and should said premises at the time of such default be occupied by the Mortgager, the Mortgagee may apply to the Judge of the County Court or to any Judge of the Count of Common fleas who shall be resident or presiding in the county aforesaid for the appointment of a receiver with authority to take passession of said premises and profits actually collected.
- 13. That the Mortgagee, at its option, may require the Mortgager to pay to the Mortgagee, on the first day of each month until the note secured hereby is fully paid, the following sums in addition to the payments of principal and interest provided in said note: a sum equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of mortgage guaranty insurance (if applicable), fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes, and assessments next due on the mortgaged premises (all as estimated by the Mortgagee) less all shins already paid therefor, divided by the number of muchs to elapse before one month prior to the date when such premiums. Taxes, and assessments will be due and payable, such agus to be held by Mortgagee for taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums, the excess may be credited by the Mortgagee and subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagers fall pay to the Mortgagee any amounts necessary to make up the delicioney. The Mortgage further agrees that at the end of ten years from the date hereof, Mortgagee may, at its outton, apply for granewal of mortgage guaranty or similar insurance (If applicable) givering the balance then remaining due on the mortgage eath, and the Mortgage may at its outton, apply for granewal of mortgage guaranty or similar insurance (If applicable) givering the balance then remaining the on the mortgage eath, and the Mortgager may at its option, pay the single premium required for the remaining years of the term, or the Mortgagee may pay when premium and add the sums to the nortgage debt, in which event the Mortgager shall repay to Mortgagee such premium, payment, with interest, at the rate specified in said promissory note, in equal monthly installments over the remaining payment payment, with interest, at the rate specified in said promissory note, in equal monthly installments over the remaining payment payment.
