together with all rights, interests, easements, hereditaments and appurtenences thereunto belonging, the rents, issues, and profits thereof and reverbes and income therefrom, all improvements and personal property now or later attached thereto or reasonably necessary to the use thereof, including, but not limited to 'ranges, refrigerators, or carpeting purchased or financed in whole or in part with loan funds, all water, feater rights, and water stock pertaining thereto, and all psyments at any time owing to Borrower by virtue of any sales are transfer conveyance, or condemnation of any part therefor or interest that are the rein called "the property virtue of any sales are transfer conveyance, or condemnation of any part therefor interest that are the rein called "the property virtue of any sales are transfer to the AVE AND TO HOLD the property unto the Government and its assigns forever.

BORBOWER for himself, his beirs, executors, administrators, successors and sales was NARRENTS THE TITLE to the property to the Government against all lawful claims and demands whatsoever except any liens, encumbrances, assements, reservations, or conveyances specified hereinabove, and COVERANTS AND AGREES as follows:

(1) To pay promptly when due any inadottedness to the Government hereby secured and to indemnity and save harmless the Government against any loss under its insurance of payment of the note by reason of any defaults by Borrower. At all times when the note is held by an insured lender, Borrower shall-continue to make payments on the softe to the Government gent for the holder.

(2) To pay the Government mote is held by an insured lender, any wount doe, and under the terms of the note; less the motem of

Administration.

(3) At all times when the note is held by an insured lender, any known day, and unpaid under the terms of the note; less the snown of any annual charge, may be paid by the Government to the holder of the note as provided in the insurence endorsement for the account of Borrower. Any amount due and unpaid under the terms of the note, whether it is sheld by the Government on the note, and therebyes shell constitute as advance by the florement for the account of Borrower. Any advance by the Government as described in this paragraph shall bear interest at the note rate from the date of which the amount of the advance was due to the date of payment to the Government.
