MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

1, Earl C. Fritz, of Greenville County
(horoinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(8) GREETINGS:
WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of
Twenty Thousand and No/100 (\$ 26,000.00)
Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note does not contain a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 0 and 10 of this mortgago provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain
conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of
One Hundred Forty-Seven and 80/100 147.80) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable 25 years after date; and

WHEREAS: said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past-due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable; and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagor for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance promiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW. KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Oneal Township, being shown as a 9: 30 acre tract and 0. 92 acre lot on a plat of Property of Estate of W. W. Epps prepared by Terry T. Dill, Registered C. E. and L. S., February 26, 1959, subdivided October 1, 1969 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book SSS at Page 292 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of South Carolina Highway 253, said pin being 560.5 feet in the direction N. 46-50 W. from an iron pin at the corner of other property belong to J. R. Fowler and running thence N. 45-45 E. 1.407.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 85-15 W. 364.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 81-00 W. 98.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 45-45 W. 918.5 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of a lot belonging to C. E. Epps; thence along a line of that lot, S. 44-38 W. 200.0 feet to an iron pin on the northeastern side of South Carolina Highway 253; thence along the northeastern side of South Carolina Highway 253; thence along the northeastern side of South Carolina Highway 253, S. 45-22 E. 200.0 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the northeastern side of said Highway. S. 46-10 E. 150.0 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Carroll E. Epps by deed of even date to be recorded herewith.
