

4. All that lot of land with the improvements thereon situate on the southeast side of Craven Alley (formerly known as McCarter Alley) in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S.C., being designated as Lots 4 and 5 in a division of the Butler and Davis Lands, said lot having a frontage of 86 feet, more or less, on the southeast side of Craven Alley, and running back in parallel lines to a depth of 100 feet to line of property now or formerly of Mrs. Lovelace, and adjoining lands now or formerly of T. Q. Donaldson, et al, and contains 8600 square feet, more or less.

5. All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on Old Spartanburg Road (also known now or formerly as Church Street) in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 2 of Henry Benson, Sr., and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Old Spartanburg Road (Church Street according to Sheet 190 of the Tax Maps of Greenville County), the same being known, now or formerly, as the corner of the John Thompson land and running thence with the south side of said road N. 65-20 W. 85 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 20-50 W. 153 to an iron pin on the old line; thence with the said old line N. 51-10 E. 171 feet to the beginning corner, containing thirteen hundred square feet, to be the same more or less.
