together with all rights, interests; easements, hereditements and appurtenences thereanto belonging, the rents, issues, and profits thereof and revenues and income therefrom, all improvements and personal property new or later attached thereby or reasonably necessary to the use thereof, including, but not limited to, ranges, refrigerators, or terpeting purchased or financed in whole or in part with lean funds, all water, water rights, and water stock pertaining thereto, and all psymests at any time ewing to Borrower by virtue of any sale, lease, transfer, conveyance, or condemnation of any part thursel or interest therein-all of which are herein called "the property";

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property unto the Government and its assigns forever.

BORROVER for himself, his helrs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns WARRENTS THE TITLE to the property to the Government against all lawful claims and demands whatsoever except any lieus, encumbrances, essenants, reservations, or conveyances specified hereinabove, and COVENANTS AND AGREES as follows:

(1) To pay promptly when dan any indebtedness to the Government hereby necured and to indemnify and cave herniess the Government against any loss under its insurance of payment of the note by reason of any default by Borrower. At all times when the note is held by an lazared leader, Borrower shall continue to make payments on the note to the Government, as collection agent for the holder.

(2) To pay the Government such fees and other charges as may now or hereafter be required by regulations of the Farmers Home Administration.

(3) At all times when the note is held by an insured leader, any amount due and unpaid under the terms of the note, less the amount of any annual charge, may be paid by the Government to the helder of the mote as provided in the insurance endorsement for the account of Borrower.
