WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST_FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF CREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagoe) in the full and just sum of

EIGHTEEN THOUSAND AND NO/100THS -----(\$ 18,000.00)

Dollars as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain

conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of One Hundred

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagoe to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of a subdivision known as Shiloh Estates, Section 2, and having according to a plat entitled "Property of D & C Builders", prepared by T. H. Walker, Jr., dated February 3, 1973, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northerly side of McCall Road at the joint corner of Shiloh Estates Section 1 and running thence with the northerly side of McCall Road N. 80-15 W. 150 feet to a point on McCall Road; thence with the intersection of McCall Road and Costner Drive N. 35-21 W. 35.1 feet to a point on Costner Drive; thence with the easterly side of Costner Drive N. 10-10 W. 192.6 feet to a point; thence with the line of Lot No. 2 S. 79-50 E. 175 feet to a point; thence with the line of Shiloh Estates Section 1 S. 10-10 W. 216.6 feet to an iron pin on the northerly side of McCall Road at the beginning corner.
