WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagoe to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon situate, lying corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lot 161, of a subdivision known as Isaqueena Park, a plat of which is of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book P at Pages 130-131, and according to a recent survey prepared by R. W. Dalton is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the northern side of Kirkwood Lane, at the joint front corner of lots 160 and 161, and running thence N. 14-29 E. 175 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of lots 160 and 161; thence S. 66-54 E. 62.8 W. 173.7 feet to a point on the northern side of Kirkwood Lane at the joint front corner of lots 161 and 162; thence with the northern side of Kirkwood Land, N. 66-31 W. 45 feet to a point; thence continuing with the northern side of Kirkwood Land, N. 72-31 W. 28.6 feet to the point of beginning.
