NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying and being in the Piedmont Manufacturing

Company Village in or near the Town of Piedmont, Greenville County, and being more particularly described as Lot No. 95, Section 4, as shown on a plat entitled "Property of Piedmont Manufacturing Co., Greenville County" made by Dalton & Neves, February, 1950; Sections 3 and 4 of said plat are recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "Y" at pages 2-5, inclusive and pages 6-9, inclusive, respectively. According to said plat the within described lot is also known as No. 3 Hammett Street (Avenue) and fronts thereon 100 feet. This is the same property conveyed to Gilbert L. Ivie and Victoria G. Ivie by deeds of Arthur Charles Verner and Frederick Duncan Verner, dated January 31, 1972, said deeds recorded in Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 939 of Deeds, page 94 and Book 939 of Deeds, page 93, respectively.

Also, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being in the Piedmont Manufacturing Company Village in or near the Town of Piedmont being known and designated as Lot No. 21, Section 4 as shown on a plat entitled "Property of Piedmont Manufacturing Co., Greenville County" made by Dalton & Neves, February, 1950, of sections 3 and 4 of said subdivision. Said plat is recorded in Plat Book Y at pages 6 and 9. This property is also known as No. 9 Langston Street (Avenue) and fronts thereon 100 feet. This being the same property conveyed to Gilbert L. Ivie by deed recorded in Deed Book 864, at page 587, RMC Office for Greenville, County.
