All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, being known as Lot No. 33 of a subdivision known as New Furman Heights, and being more particularly described according to plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE at Page 75, as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Blackstone Drive, joint front corner of Lots 33 and 32, and running thence along the line of said lots, N. 87-52 W. 150 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 33 and 34; running thence along the line of said lots, S. 23-30 E. 165.6 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Ruby Drive; running thence along the northern side of Ruby Drive, which line is curved, the chord of which is N. 61-49 E. 20 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said line, which line is curved, the chord of which is N. 43-41 E. 74.1 feet to an iron pin; thence along the western side of Blackstone Drive, which drive is curved, the chord of which is N. 12-39 E. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said drive, N. 2-05 W. 15 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning; being the same conveyed to us by Leslie & Shaw, Inc. by deed dated September 13, 1955, and recorded in the R.M.C.
