That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted gee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortg sideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3,00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Cleveland Township, on the northern side of Middle Saluda River, containing 2.4 acres, more or less, as shown on plat by W. A. Hester dated March, 1943, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North bank of the Middle Saluda River at Merian J. Brown, and running thence N 2 E 874.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S 13 E 1,036.2 feet to a point on the north bank of said river; thence with the center of said river as the line, in a northwesterly direction, 264 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning and being triangular in shape, and being the same conveyed to me in Deed Book 951, at page 318.
