TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: Michael G. Moore and Minnie Marton

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of Five thousand five hundred and no/100ths----- DOLLARS

(\$ 5,500.00), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable as therein stated or as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is seven (7) years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, on the eastern side of Baker Road, just off White Horse Road, about 4 1/2 miles from the Greenville County Courthouse, and being known and designated as Lot No. 3 on plat of property of Oscar F. Baker, recorded in Plat Book P, at Page 111, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the eastern side of Baker Road, at a point 200 feet north of the intersection of Baker Road and White Horse Road, and running thence along line of Lot Nos. 2 and 1, S 76 E 200 feet to stake at rear corner of Lot No. 1; thence N 4-15 E 100 feet to stake at corner of Lot No. 4; thence with line of Lot No. 4, N 76 W 200 feet to pin on Baker Road; thence along the eastern side of Baker Road, S 4-15 W 100 feet to the beginning corner.

The above-described property was conveyed to the Mortgagor by deed of Minnie Marton reserving into herself a life estate in said property; said deed is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 950 at Page 276.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
