

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW. KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagoe to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, bying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northern side of Waterloo Circle, being known and designated as Lot No. 13 as shown on plat entitled BOILING SPRINGS ESTATES, dated July, 1961, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "YY" at Pages 14-15 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Waterloo Circle at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 13 and 14 and running thence with the common line of said Lots, N. 61-26 E. 213.8 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 12, 13, 14 and 15; thence running with the common line of Lots Nos. 12 and 13, S. 22-17 E. 240 feet to an iron pin on the northwestern side of Waterloo Circle at the joint front corner of Lots Nos 12 and 13; thence running with the northwestern side of Waterloo Circle, the following courses and distances: S. 63-23 W. 34.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 55-58 W. 59.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 51-26 W. 45.85 feet to an iron pin at the curve on the northwestern side of Waterloo Circle; thence with the curve of Waterloo Circle, the following courses and distances: S. 76-26 W. 35.45 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 53-34 following courses and distances: S. 76-26 W. 35.45 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 53-34 with the northern side of Waterloo Circle, N. 28-34 W. 209.8 feet to the point of beginning.
