MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and alide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgage, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagoe for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or bereafter to be constructed thereon, situate bring and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and being shown as Lot No. 110 on a plat of Oak Crest, Section II, prepared by C. C. Jones & Associates, dated January, 1955, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book GG at pages 130 and 131, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Garren Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 109 and 110 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 109 S. 77-04 W. 206.1 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 106; thence with the line of Lot No. 106 N. 64-42 W. 29.2 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 99; thence with the line of Lot No. 99 N. 36-27 E. 82 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 110 and 111; thence with the line of Lot No. 111 N. 78-25 E. 170.6 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Garren Drive; thence with the western side of Garren Drive S. 11-23 E. 20.4 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the western side of Garren Drive S. 12-56 E. 49.6 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of Brown, Inc., dated June 24, 1958, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 600 at page 533.
