WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto TRYON FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF TRYON, N. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released; and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

All those two (2) certain lots or parcels of land being known and designated as Lots Numbers 700 and 701, as shown on a Plat of Lake Lanier Development, said Plat having been prepared by George Kershaw, and duly recorded in Plat Records in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina; each of said lots having a frontage of 50 feet and a depth of 140 feet.

And there is also conveyed the rights of enjoyments of privileges and facilities afforded by Lake Lanier for sports, boating, swimming and fishing, and erection of boat houses, as are contained in the Deed of Lake Lanier Company, to T. M. Lyles, C. E. Daniel and Chas. M. Drummons, recorded in Book 123, Page 51, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, and subject to the restrictions therein.
